

COLOMBIA & CHILE ITINERARY



May 4, 2024

MIAMI - BOGOTA

This afternoon fly aboard the scheduled airline, selected by Pollina Tours from Miami, US to Bogota, Colombia.

May 5, 2024

ARRIVE IN BOGOTA

Welcome and assistance upon arrival at the airport by your local English-speaking guide. Transfer to your deluxe hotel.

You will begin your afternoon in colorful **La Candelaria** - the heart of Bogota's historic center. Amble along its narrow streets, visiting cultural landmarks and local shops selling artisanal goods. Eventually, you will reach **Plaza Bolívar**, the city's main square dating back to 1539

There is a *Grand Cathedral* here as well as many important government buildings, such as the *Capitolio Nacional* (Colombia's congress building).

In the evening enjoy a **Colombian Folklore Show**.

Overnight in Bogota.







May 6, 2024

BOGOTA

Enjoy a visit to another landmark of Bogota, an *Underground Cathedral* located in Colombia, built 180m underground, it is a mega structure that deserves to be among the most impressive in our country and on the planet.

The entire structure of this cathedral is carved from salt from the largest salt rock deposit in the world. During the tour there are several stations where you will see the interpretation of the Christian way of the cross.

The central dome where Eucharists are held, intervened by an amazing artistic work of sculpture and lighting, and natural structures typical of salt deposits, a set of elements that will leave you breathless.

Once you finish the tour of the salt mine, the town of *Zipaquirá* awaits us to visit its central square, some of its beautiful colonial-looking streets where we will find the ideal place to enjoy a typical lunch.

Return to your hotel in Bogota.



May 7, 2024

BOGOTA - CARTAGEÑA

Today transfer to the airport for your flight to *Cartageña*. This colonial fortress city on the Caribbean Sea is rich in culture, architecture, romance, and even pirate history.

Upon arrival, you will be welcome and assisted by your local guide. Later transfer to your hotel.





Day 4

May 7, 2024

CARTAGEÑA (Day 4 Continued)

This afternoon experience the "Pearl of the Caribbean" on a walking tour. Let these cobbled streets transfer you back to colonial times as you stroll amid colorful houses and lively squares.

You will start in the expansive *Plaza de los* Coches, at the entrance to the Old Town.

Finish your day tour at the yellow arcades and galleries of Plaza Las Bovedas, experiencing all of Cartageña in between.

Rest of the day enjoy the beach in Cartageña. Overnight in Cartageña

May 8, 2024

CARTAGEÑA

Tour Cartageña and discover the best of what the city has to offer on this sightseeing trip.

You will explore ancient locations on this Cartageña trip, including the San Felipe Castle and its panoramic views, **Saint Peter Claver Church**, and more. This tour covers the area's most distinguished top attractions, and turns into a fun half-day adventure.

Your city tour begins with a drive around **Manga Island**, a stunning enclave famed for its opulent residences and affluent residents.

Next, your journey will lead you towards the Monastery of la Candelaria situated atop Popa Hill, which stands as the highest point in the city.





May 8, 2024

CARTAGEÑA (Day 5 Continued)

This will be followed by a photo stop at the remarkable **San Felipe Fort**, recognized as one of the most outstanding forts in the Americas.

San Felipe Fort, is an impressive fortress with origins dating back to the 1600s.

A monument, portrays an old pair of shoes and pays homage to a poem written by a local poet.

Then, we will take you on a guided tour of **Saint Pedro Claver Church**. You will have the opportunity to visit **Castillo Grande** and **Cartageña Bay**.

Admission to the **Monastery of La Candelaria** and **Saint Pedro Claver Church** are **included** in this Cartageña historical tour.

Overnight in Cartageña.







May 9, 2024

CARTAGEÑA

Enjoy a full day to explore more of Cartageña or choose an optional visit to Tutomo volcano for a mud bath (\$45 per person) or simply relax on the famous beaches of Cartageña.

Totumo Volcano, one of the smallest volcanos in the world, is known for its rejuvenating mud baths and views of the region.

From your hotel in Cartageña, sit back and travel for about an hour, passing by the impressive tropical landscapes of the Bolivar Region, to the municipality of Santa Catalina.

Upon arrival, climb up and inside Totumo Volcano and dive into its mud that offers a natural form of water and mineral therapy that provides skin rejuvenation and relaxation.

Legend has it that the volcano used to spew lava and ash until a priest poured holy water onto it, taming it into the natural mud bath spa it is today.

At an elevation of 50 feet, the view of the surrounding mountains, lakes, and forests from the crater makes the experience even more relaxing and enjoyable.

After your mud bath spa and rinsing in the lake, it is time to satisfy your palate with a delicious typical lunch.

Return to your hotel in Cartageña.

May 10, 2024

CARTAGEÑA, COLOMBIA -SANTIAGO, CHILE

Transfer to Cartageña airport for your flight to Santiago, Chile.

Arrive in Santiago.

Welcome and assistance upon arrival at the airport by our professional local Englishspeaking guide.

Transfer to your deluxe hotel.

In the evening, enjoy a folklore show and dinner at a local restaurant.

Overnight in Santiago.



May 11, 2024

SANTIAGO, CHILE

After breakfast, tour Santiago city with your local English-speaking guide. Visit modern financial areas of Santiago.
Pass by *Barrio Universitario* (University Area) and lively *Plaza de Armas*.

Drive by green *Parque Forestal* Fine Arts museum and the bohemian neighborhood of Bellavista.

Climb up **San Cristóbal Hill** viewpoint for birds-eye views of the city and the Andean mountains in the background.

May 12, 2024

VALPARAISO & VIÑA DEL MAR

Today, we will pick you up from your hotel and take you on a full-day trip visit to Valparaíso, the most important port of Chile, constructed on the steep slope of a hill, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

Starting in *Plaza Victoria*, we will continue to explore downtown and *Plaza Sotomayor*, until finally reaching the **Prat port**. From there we'll take our first gondola of the day and head to the beautiful *Palacio Baburizza*, constructed in 1916.

Pass by the colorful houses that stare down from above the city and the bay, and descend once again by taking another gondola.

Leaving Valparaiso, we will head to *Viña del* Mar, the favorite Chilean summer-vacation destination.

Enjoy a relaxing evening walking on the coast and the pier which extends into the Pacific Ocean, and visit the beautiful "Reloj de Flores", a giant clock that is entirely made of flowers.

At the end of the day, we'll drive you back to your hotel in Santiago de Chile.

MAY 4 - 17, 2024

May 13, 2024

SANTIAGO - CALAMA -SAN PEDRO ATACAMA

After breakfast, fly to Calama.

Upon arrival, get welcomed and assisted by your local guide.

Transfer to your hotel in **San Pedro de Atacama.** (About 2 hours drive).

This city of little adobe houses, of unpaved streets and cozy restaurants, is the base to begin exploring one of Chile's most spectacular environments.

In the afternoon, take your first tour of Atacama and visit the *Cejar* and *Tebenquiche Lagoons*, inside the great *Atacama Salt Flats*, where you'll be able to bathe in their clear turquoise waters with and amazing volcano backdrop.





Then, step into the heart of the salt flats and visit the "*Ojo del Salar*" (Salt Flats' Eyes), two round freshwater wellsprings in the middle of the desert, next to the impressive Andes Mountain Range.





SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA (Day 10 Continued)

At the end of this relaxing trip drive back to San Pedro de Atacama to enjoy the rest of the evening eating a pastel de choclo (a corn-based cake) at one of the cozy restaurants on *Caracoles Street* (the main road).

San Pedro de Atacama is also one of the **best places to stargaze in the whole world**. With this altitude, you'll see the clearest skies of your life. Make sure you don't waste the opportunity and get out there to chase some starlight!

Overnight at hotel in San Pedro de Atacama.





May 14, 2024

SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA

Today, you will travel 40 miles to the north of Atacama Salt Flats.

Start the day by visiting the **Chaxa Lagoon**, one of the **best places to see flamingos** inside the natural reserve.

Discover the salt crusts, produced by the evaporation of water, which cover the land from North to South as you move your way through the desert to reach the Highland Lakes, at an altitude of 14,000 feet.

Miscanti and Miñiques, better known as the Highland Lakes, are two neighboring lagoons formed by the eruption of the Miñiques Volcano, which can be seen in the background of these pristine waters.





Continue your journey by visiting the village of **Socaire**, where you can taste the best Atacamenian cuisine, and the town of **Toconao**, an oasis in the middle of Atacama Desert.

Fruits and vegetables grow freely in this village that is made entirely from volcanic stone (known as 'liparita' stone).

After exploring these interesting traditions and cultures of the Atacamenians, drive back to your hotel in San Pedro de Atacama.



May 15, 2024

SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA

Full-day visit to **Geysers del Tatio and Moon** Valley.

This morning, you will see two highlights of the Atacama region: Geysers del Tatio and The Moon Valley. This is a full-day experience, and your last day in Atacama!


First, you will travel to where the crevices of the Earth exhale their millenary breath.

At about 4 a.m., we pick you up to take you 60 miles away from San Pedro de Atacama into the Andes to see the geothermal field of Geysers del Tatio (the highest in the world). Here, you'll see 40 geysers and 70 hot springs fighting against the super low temperatures of the first morning hours (their waters can reach up to 185 °F).

Take the most impressive photos, **swim in the Tatio Spring's rich mineral waters**, and enjoy a complete breakfast with this magnificent backdrop.

On your way back, visit the quaint village of Machuca (at 13000 feet above sea level), with barely 20 adobe houses and a traditional church that locals visit daily to ask the Virgin to give them water. This is the perfect opportunity to get closer to the inner mountain culture of the region, and to try one of the best sopapillas in Chile (a fried tortilla)!









SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA (Day 12 Continued)

We will drive you back to San Pedro de Atacama, where you will depart in the afternoon on a 4-hour adventure in the *Valle de la Luna* (Moon Valley), an out-of-this-world place.

Driving straight to the desert, we'll start noticing mysterious forms of salt and clay as we get closer to the "*Three Marias*". These statues are the female guardians of this cosmic desert, so don't forget to bow and make a wish to these beautiful monuments.

The Atacama Desert is one of the world's driest and most hostile zones.



After this first encounter, take a winding and hidden path to the **Salt Caves**, and discover the peculiar salt gemstones that have formed over centuries from the lack of humidity and the altitude of this zone. The highlight of your adventure will appear at sunset, when all the colors of this incredible landscape change their palette. The forbidding **Licancabur Volcano** will turn pink while the valley awaits the rise of its lunar mother. Overnight at your hotel in San Pedro de Atacama.







Day 13

May 16, 2024

SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA -SANTIAGO DE CHILE

Today transfer from your hotel in San Pedro de Atacama to Calama airport for your flight back to Santiago.

Upon arrival in Satiago, transfer to your hotel.

Overnight at hotel in Santiago

May 17, 2024

SANTIAGO, CHILE - UNITED STATES

After breakfast, transfer from your hotel in Santiago to Santiago airport for your flight back to Miami with happy and once-in-a-lifetime memories and experiences of Colombia & Chile!

May 17, 2024

SANTIAGO, CHILE -LIMA, PERU

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight from Santiago to Bogotá, for your connecting flight to Lima.

Upon arrival, get welcomed by your local guide and transfer to your hotel.

Overnight in Lima.

May 18, 2024

LIMA - CUSCO - SACRED VALLEY

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Cusco.

Arrive in Cusco and transfer to your hotel in the **Sacred Valley** for your overnight stay.

The rest of the day is free to acclimatize to high altitude (approximately 12,000 feet above the sea level).









May 19, 2024

SACRED VALLEY - MACHU PICCHU - SACRED VALLEY

After breakfast, you will be driven to the train station to **board the panoramic train to Machu Picchu** on day return trip.

Arrive in Machu Picchu, a wonder of the world and proceed on tour of this "Lost City of the Incas", Machu Picchu, a unique, magical and mystic place.



You will be amazed as you go around Machu Picchu, the majestic and perfection of the Inca legacy. Located on top of a mountain in the middle of a tropical forest, it is considered the tourist attraction par excellence in Peru. The historic sanctuary is a place that captivates tourists not only for its dazzling architectural beauty, but also for its important historical-cultural legacy, which has led it to be recognized and admired throughout the world.

Declared A Cultural and Natural Heritage of Humanity in 1983 by UNESCO, it is probably the most amazing architectural construction of the Inca Empire. This citadel is made up of temples, palaces, terraces, monuments, complexes, and walls; in addition to water channels, built with large blocks of stone, without any amalgam – proof of the great wisdom of the Inca civilization.

Later in the afternoon transfer to the train station to board your Vista dome panoramic train back to the Sacred Valley. Arrive and transfer to hotel your hotel for your overnight stay.



Day 17

May 20, 2024

SACRED VALLEY

After breakfast, enjoy your day OR you may choose an Optional Day Tour (\$75 per person) to travel around the Sacred Valley to see some important archaeological sites such as Ollantaytambo with its fortress and the Sun Temple.

Overnight at your hotel in Sacred Valley.

May 21, 2024

SACRED VALLEY - CUSCO

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and depart by coach for Cusco, for a tour of Cusco - a city that blends Spanish colonial charm.

Visit the Main Square, the Cathedral, the Temple of the Sun at Korikancha. Visit the impressive Fortress of Sacsayhuaman built on a hill overlooking Cusco, famous for its enormous carved stones, some of them standing over 9 m / 30 ft. high and weighing over 350 tons.

Later on, check-in to your hotel in Cusco. In the evening enjoy a local folklore show and dinner.

CUSCO - LIMA

After breakfast, check-out and transfer to the airport for your flight to Lima - long considered the Colonial Capital of South America.

Arrive in Lima and transfer to the hotel.

In the afternoon, your guide will take you on the tour of Lima - also known as the city of Kings.

Visit the historic downtown area declared a world heritage site by the United Nations.

Enjoy visits to Lima's principal attractions including *The Plaza de Armas, Government* Palace, and The Cathedral.

Overnight stay in Lima.

May 23, 2024

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS:

If the tour is cancelled by the tour participants for any reason or for any circumstances beyond the control of Pollina Tours & Travel, Inc, its agents, and its service providers, the cancellation fee will be applicable. **CFAR (Cancel for Any Reason) travel insurance policy is one option that you must discuss with your Travel Insurance Company**, as it offers a wider range of coverage if you cancel for any reason.

A full 100% Refund will be made to the passengers if the tour is canceled by Pollina Tours due to the default of Pollina Tours & Travel, Inc.

It is mandatory for passengers to make all cancellations in writing, stating the reason for the cancellation, and the same must be received by our office.

Most refunds generally take 6-8 weeks to process.


HEALTH:

You must consult with your physician for every important aspect of your health-related issues, including sea sickness, motion sickness, vaccinations such as Yellow Fever, Hepatitis, malaria prophylaxis, etc. to ensure that you are in good health to engage in

Atacama, Chile and Cusco, Peru are situated almost 13,000 feet sea level. Please consult your Physician about altitude sickness.


AIRLINE GROUP BOOKING & SEAT ASSIGNMENTS:
