WARSAW, POLAND

Arrive in Warsaw, Poland.

At the Old Town you can enjoy a walking tour passing by the *Castle Square, King Sigismund's Column, St. John's Cathedral, the Old Town Market Square*and the *Barbican*.

June 18, 2024



WARSAW - AUSCHWITZ-BIRKENAU -

KRAKOW

This morning, you will drive from Warsaw to Auschwitz by a private deluxe air-conditioned motor-coach with an English speaking guide.

Continue driving to the concentration camp in Auschwitz that was established by German Nazis on the outskirts of the town Oswiecim in 1940.

After the war, the camp was turned into museum displaying evidence of the genocide.

Visit Block no. 11, also known as the Death Block where thousands of people were murdered.

Outside the camp, there is a gas chamber, where 70,000 people were killed in 1940-1943. Since 1944, transports of prisoners from all over the continent entered directly through the "Gate of Death".

Continue drive to Krakow. Arrive in Krakow in the evening and check into your hotel.

June 19, 2024

KRAKOW

In the morning enjoy a full day tour of tour of Krakow. Krakow city - the former capital of Poland, is the medieval center of merchandising.

The city which was totally undamaged during the World War II has been listed as UNESCO site.

Your Old Town tour of Krakow will include **Royal Route, Jagiellonian University** - one of the oldest medieval Century Universities of Europe, the **Main Square** - the biggest main square market in Europe, **St. Mary's Church,** and the **Royal Castle** on Wawel Hill.

June 20, 2024





KRAKOW

After a buffet breakfast, visit the **Wieliczka Salt Mines**. The Wieliczka Salt Mine is one of the most ancient mines in the world. It has been operating since the 13th century with no intermissions. In 1978 it was listed at UNESCO World Culture and National Heritage Site.

The tourist route open for visitors connects three levels and reaches 135 meters under the surface. Besides the Tourist Route, the underground passages and chambers house the *Krakow Salt-Works Museum*, one of the largest mining-related museums in Europe. The museum's collection can be

admired both underground at level 3 of the mine, & in the Salt-Works Castle.

Arrive and check in at the hotel. Overnight in Krakow.



June 21, 2024

KRAKOW - BUDAPEST, HUNGARY

After breakfast, check out and continue on the drive to Budapest, Hungary.

Arrive in Budapest and check into your hotel.

In the evening enjoy a *River Cruise on the Danube* that features Hungarian opera singers and performers to entertain you as you cruise past the wonderful sights of the city of Budapest, which has been part of the UNESCO World Heritage for its special beauty & glamor. Enjoy the dinner aboard the cruise.

After the breakfast, enjoy your tour of Budapest. Visit the *Hungarian Parliament* - the 3rd biggest parliament in the whole World, and the biggest, most expensive building in Hungary.

June 27, 2024


VIENNA - PRAGUE, CZECHIA

Overnight in Prague.







FORM OF PAYMENT:

Please make the check payable to **Pollina Tours & Travel, Inc** for USD 500 per person before February 25, 2024, to take advantage of the early bird discount.

If paying by credit card, there is a 3.5% processing fee.

The final payment is due 120 days before departure.

NOT INCLUDED:

Not included in the Land Cost are any international airfare, the costs of any Government required mandatory vaccinations, and charges needed to embark on the trip such as, Visa fees, Travel Insurance, porterage at the airport, alcohol, items of a personal nature such as laundry, tips or gratuities, telephone, room service, any increase of government-imposed taxes, other items not mentioned in the tour inclusion list.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

Pollina Tours does not sell any travel insurance. We strongly recommend that you obtain comprehensive Travel Insurance coverage, including but not limited to trip cancellation, delay, loss of deposit, medical expenses, personal accidents and death, loss of baggage, and personal belongings.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS:

If the tour is cancelled by the tour participants for any reason or for any circumstances beyond the control of Pollina Tours & Travel, Inc, its agents, and its service providers, the cancellation fee will be applicable. **CFAR (Cancel for Any Reason) travel insurance policy is one option that you must discuss with your Travel Insurance Company**, as it offers a wider range of coverage if you cancel for any reason.

We highly recommend purchasing a Travel Insurance policy from the travel insurance company of your choice, covering all eventualities including, but not limited to, trip delay, trip cancellation, medical evacuation, illness, pandemic, an endemic, outbreak of disease, terrorism, inclement weather, natural disaster, death of the traveler, accident, etc. that can protect yourself from the cancellation fees as mentioned in the chart below:

Between 179 Days - 120 Days of Departure	25% of the Tour Cost
Between 119 Days - 90 Days of Departure	50% of the Tour Cost
Between 89 Days - 60 Days of Departure	75 % of the Tour Cost
Within 59 Days of Departure	100% of the Tour Cost

A full 100% Refund will be made to the passengers if the tour is canceled by Pollina Tours due to the default of Pollina Tours & Travel, Inc.

It is mandatory for passengers to make all cancellations in writing, stating the reason for the cancellation, and the same must be received by our office.


Most refunds generally take 6-8 weeks to process.

HOTEL BOOKING:

POLLINA TOURS makes the booking of the hotel/cruise in the specified hotel/cruise in Standard twin-bedded (two single beds) rooms or "Standard" double bedded (one double bed) room with private facilities, unless you have specifically requested and paid for an upgraded room category. Special requests, such as bed types, smoking preferences, and connecting rooms are subject to availability.

Room selection in all cases, unless otherwise reserved, is strictly at the discretion of the hotel's management on a run-of-house basis.

AIRLINE GROUP BOOKING & SEAT ASSIGNMENTS:

POLLINA TOURS makes the booking with the Group Department of the airline, which means all the group members must travel together to and from a common gateway, as one Group.

The Group tickets are lower fare tickets and carry restrictions. The tickets are nonrefundable, on-transferable, non-reroutable, and non-endorsable.

Policies governing seat assignments for groups vary greatly by airline. Most airlines currently offer preferred seating, a system that allows them to charge additional fees for more desirable seats, which may include window and aisle seats. As a result, many seats displayed on airline seat maps are set aside for clients willing to pay additional fees for them. Some seats may only be accessible at airport check-in, although sometimes passengers with frequent flyer status may have earlier access.

Seat assignment preferences are not guaranteed by Pollina Tours. Airline reservation agents are often prohibited from assisting with seat requests for group reservations.


